LT Williams is the JOAG Dental PAC liaison for the 2 year term starting October 2011. His education includes a Bachelor of Science degree from Northeastern State University, Tahlequah, OK and a Doctor of Dental Surgery degree from The University of Iowa College of Dentistry, Iowa City, IA. LT Williams is a Staff Dental Officer for the Oklahoma Area Indian Health Service stationed at the Lawton Indian Hospital (LIH). His duties include providing comprehensive patient care including yearly diabetic and Head Start exams, as well as, regularly scheduled patients and patients with emergent needs. LT Williams currently serves as the Acting Chief Dental Officer Complex Clinic (O-6 Billet) and has held that position from OCT 2009 – JUL 2010 and from FEB 2011 through the present date. LT Williams also serves as the Dental Performance Improvement Coordinator, Dental Infection Control Officer, and Hospital Equipment Committee Chairman.

LT Williams accepted his commission in the Commissioned Corps of the United States Public Health Service following graduation from the University of Iowa College of Dentistry in 2008. He has shown his dedication to the Commissioned Corp by becoming an active member in his local COA Chapter. LT Williams has also been actively involved with the Office of Force Readiness and Deployment. He deployed aboard the USNS Comfort (T-AH 20) for Operation Continuing Promise 2009, as well as, for Hurricane Irene in 2011. He has also participated in the Field Medical Readiness Training Exercise with Rapid Deployment Force Team 3 at Fort A.P. Hill in Bowling Green, Virginia and Operation Foothold in Pahducuh, KY. LT Williams was selected as the recipient of the Oklahoma City Area Indian Health Service Clinician of the Year Award in his first year as a commissioned officer, and was awarded the 2010 National Oral Health Council of the IHS Clinical Excellence Award for the Junior Category. In the community, LT Williams represents USPHS as a member of the Kiowa Tribe of Oklahoma Health Services Advisory Committee. LT Williams is also actively involved
