- The Mid-Atlantic Regional Chief Pharmacist position has closed and the applicant board has been submitted to BOP Chief Pharmacist for selection
- Central Fill mechanism is being analyzed for BOP Care Level 1 (AKA: Healthy) institutions - Bureau of Prisons Mail Order Pharmacy (BOPMOP)
- A workgroup of BOP pharmacists and nurses is developing an Antimicrobial Stewardship Guide and Outpatient IV Therapy Guide
- Regional Hepatitis C Clinical Pharmacist Consultants (collateral duty) have been selected
- National P&T Meeting has been deferred to the beginning of May because of the budget
