AIR FORCE: Staff Social Worker - 436th Medical Operations Squadron (MDOS) /Mental Health Flight, Dover AFB; Dover, DE (O-3 billet, Non-Supervisory)

Job Description:

The scope of privileges in clinical social work includes evaluation, diagnosis, treatment, and consultation for patients with psychological disorders. Social workers apply clinical social work techniques for the purpose of understanding, preventing, and relieving psychological-based distress or dysfunction and to promote subjective well-being and personal development. They determine risk for harm, fitness for duty, and suitability for special assignments. Providers work with individuals of all ages, couples, families, groups, and communities. Clinical social workers provide comprehensive behavioral health services in multiple settings, including clinic, family advocacy program, substance abuse treatment program, and service specific programs. Diagnosis and management; administration and interpretation of screening and assessment instruments; conduct family advocacy assessment, case management, and presentation of cases of partner/family maltreatment to the committee in accordance with DoD guidance; conduct sexual assessment in accordance with service requirements; conduct command/unit needs assessment; consult with medical/allied health agencies; personnel assessment and selection for special programs (i.e., security clearance, PRP, special duty); substance abuse treatment. Therapies: individual, group, marital/couples, family, crisis intervention. Potential supported privileges: formal sex therapy; biofeedback; hypnosis.

Rotate after hours on-call phone amongst provider staff, strictly consultative; no travel.

Will at least spend 51% of time on direct mental health patient care and/or mental health clinical management.

Must maintain all basic readiness standards as required by the U.S. Public Health Service. Requires a SECRET clearance.

PHS officers assigned under this Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) must remain available for PHS deployments. Under this MOA, PHS officers are not authorized to deploy with the military.

Requirements:

License: A current, unrestricted, and valid independent social work license from a U.S. State (as defined in 42 USC 201 (f)) is required. Masters Degree in Social Work from a school or social work fully accredited by the Council on Social Work Education (CSWE).

Additional Requirements:

At least one full year post-license clinical social work experience in an outpatient/inpatient setting.

Initial assignment term is a 3-year obligation, with the option to extend.
