United States Air Force: Program Director for Tele-Mental Health/Virtual Reality Treatment, Travis Air Force Base, CA, (O4 Billet Supervisory)

Job Description:

Provides programmatic oversight to the largest USAF Tele-Mental Health consulting hub in the Western United States. Develops communication links with satellite Mental Health facilities in all Services and the U.S. Coast Guard to include psychiatric medication consultation, sanity boards, commander-directed mental health evaluations, and supervision of unlicensed mental health providers. Directs utilization of and training for state-of-the-art virtual reality treatment for Post Traumatic Stress Disorder and other anxiety disorders, critical to the recovery of Wounded Warriors. Also provides direct clinical care including comprehensive psychological assessment, individual and group treatment, and psychological testing in an outpatient mental health clinic supporting over 10,000 annual visits for both DoD active duty and TRICARE beneficiaries. Conducts special duty and security clearance evaluations. Advises commanders on MH issues and conducts commander-directed evaluations. Provides around the clock emergent consultation to Emergency Department personnel. Provides teaching and supervisory support to the Social Work Residency Program. Will periodically fill in for the OIC of the MH Element.

Supervises Social Work Residents during clinic rotations and Psychologists just out of residency who are working to obtain licensure. Fills in for OIC of Mental Health Element at times.

(At minimum 51% of the officer's time will be in clinical mental health work.)

Requirements:

License: A current, unrestricted, and valid license as a clinical psychologist from a U.S. State, District of Columbia, Commonwealth, Territory, or other jurisdiction is required.

Training: The candidate must possess a qualifying doctoral degree in clinical psychology from an American Psychological Association (APA) accredited university or professional psychology program. Shall have completed an APA accredited internship/residency in clinical psychology.

Additional Requirements:

Would prefer someone with experience in tele-mental health, however this is an emerging field and as long as the candidate is willing to explore this area and obtain necessary training that would be sufficient

David Grant Medical Center has an active ED and consultation of MH services is required. All active duty AF, PHS and many of our civilian and contract positions share call duty.
