

Job Title:

Clinical Psychologist: Cannon AFB (O3 to O4 Billet)

Job Description:

The selected candidate will provide direct patient care to beneficiaries, which may include active duty, family members and retirees, and outreach services. Much direct patient care would be accomplished in the form of individual therapy, but many clinics have psychoeducational groups and/or are able to develop new groups based on local patient needs and skills/interests of providers.

Individual clinical services could also include performing functions such as psychological testing; special duty clearances, including overseas clearances; security clearance evaluations; command directed evaluations; participating in medical evaluation boards and administrative separations. Outreach activities could include assisting the Family Advocacy Program (FAP), the Alcohol Drug Abuse Prevention and Treatment (ADAPT) program or the Suicide Prevention program.

Additional outreach activities might include providing unit briefings on mental health issues or speaking to a deployed spouses group. USPHS psychologists would be expected to perform administrative functions such as developing productivity reports, managing clinic templates, etc based on the needs of the local clinic. USPHS officers assigned to Air Force MTFs would be expected to participate in the after-hours call schedule.

In all cases, specific duties would be based on the needs of the local clinic. The Air Force typically considers USPHS officers at the rank of O3 to O4. While USPHS officers assigned to an Air Force MTF should not necessarily anticipate filling a leadership position, such as Flight Commander or Element Chief, such roles are not necessarily precluded.

Requirements:

License: A current, unrestricted and valid license as a clinical psychologist from a U.S. State, District of Columbia, Commonwealth, Territory, or other jurisdiction is required.

Training: The candidate must possess a qualifying doctoral degree in clinical psychology from an American Psychological Association accredited university or professional psychology program. An APA accredited internship is also required.

This position is for a minimum 3 year commitment.
