

**Job Title:**

Clinical Psychologist, RAF Lakenheath, United Kingdom

**Job Description:**

Provide direct patient care to beneficiaries, which may include active duty, family members and retirees.

Direct Clinical/Counseling Psychology. Responsible for and applies psychological procedures and techniques, including interviewing, behavioral assessment, cognitive-behavioral therapy, and psychological testing / psychodiagnostic testing, the evaluation, diagnosis, and treatment of psychological and neuropsychological disorders. The following are desirable skills:

- a. Individual, family, couples, and group psychotherapy, alcohol and drug treatment evaluations
- b. Consultation with medical personnel, legal authorities, military commanders, and school districts, as required
- c. Maintenance of accurate and current notes in both the Mental Health Clinic records and patient medical records of all patients seen, as appropriate, and produce reports of evaluation and/or treatment as required
- d. Participation in military specific training (for example, training to perform Command Directed Evaluations, security clearances, Military Training Instructor clearances, etc.)

(At minimum 51% of the officer's time will be in clinical mental health work.)

Attend and participate in meetings during normal duty hours and professional staff conferences and other appropriate professional activities such as, but not limited to the following: Quality Improvement Meeting, professional staff meetings, Commander's staff meetings, Department meetings, and others required by applicable regulations, MTF guidance, or as directed by the Mental Health Clinic Chief or his/her delegated representative.

USPHS officers assigned to Air Force MTFs would be expected to participate in the after-hours call schedule. In all cases, specific duties would be based on the needs of the local clinic. While USPHS officers assigned to an Air Force MTF should not necessarily anticipate filling a leadership position, such roles are not necessarily precluded.

**Requirements:**

License: A current, unrestricted and valid license to practice psychology from a U.S. State, District of Columbia, Commonwealth, Territory, or other jurisdiction acceptable for credentialing at RAF Lakenheath Medical Group.

Training: Have a Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) or (Psy.D.) degree in clinical or counseling psychology, preferably from an APA-accredited psychological program (or a program acceptable to the Office of the Surgeon General, U.S. Air Force).

Shall have completed an APA accredited internship/residency in clinical or counseling psychology (or an internship/residency acceptable to the Office of the Surgeon General, U.S. Air Force.)

**Additional Requirements:**

RAF Lakenheath's Medical Group has an active Emergency Department and consultation of MH services is required. All Active Duty AF, PHS providers share on call duty.

Minimum 3 year commitment.
