Job Description:

Manages local ADAPT Program in accordance with current policies and guidance. Coordinates clinic resources to provide effective education, identification, assessment, and treatment program (including early intervention/Level 0.5 and outpatient programs/Level I) as defined in the current American Society of Addiction and Medicine (ASAM) Patient Placement Criteria for the Treatment of Substance-Related Disorders. Coordinates funding requirements through the wing budgeting cycle. Coordinates with off-base resources to effectively supplement the base ADAPT programs. Ensures development and implementation of ADAPT education programs. Assists commanders and supervisors to identify and refer individuals needing ADAPT services. Ensures that all care and services provided by non-privileged personnel are supervised in accordance with AFI 44-119, Medical Quality Operations, and other applicable Air Force policy. Proposes written wing or installation guidance concerning alcohol and drug abuse prevention and treatment. Ensures continuous quality improvements in the ADAPT Program by developing and tracking metrics related to alcohol and drug abuse prevention and treatment. Provides leadership, managerial guidance, and clinical supervision to the ADAPT staff. Conducts required reviews of the patients' medical records and all documentation provided by the ADAPT Program staff on a priority basis. Observes the patients' general physical and mental condition during the assessment. Refers for additional medical, psychiatric, or laboratory examinations as needed. Chairs Treatment Team (TT) meetings. Ensures non-privileged ADAPT personnel are trained and certified or actively participating in the certification process. Markets ADAPT Programs to senior leadership on the installation and to the base populations. Ensures that the SGP, as chair of the Deployment Availability Working Group (DAWG), is provided with the treatment status of all ADAPT Program clients, including their profile status, on a monthly basis. Supervises social work and/or psychology residents within the scope of the ADAPT Program functions.

Must be a credentialed/privileged mental health providers (social worker) proficient in the use of Cognitive-Behavioral Therapy Methods.

Must have a Secret (or higher) security clearance.

At least 51% of the incumbent's time will be spent on direct mental health patient care and/or mental health clinical management.

Requirements:

License: A current valid, unrestricted, registration or certification that allows of independent clinical social work practice in a U.S. State or other jurisdiction is required.

Training: The Candidate must possess a qualifying master's degree in social work that has been accredited by the Council on Social Work Education (CSWE).
