ARMY MEDCOM : Program Manager, Patient Centered Medical Home (Psychologist) - Walter Reed National Military Medical Center Bethesda, MD (O-6 billet, Non-Supervisory)

Job Description:

Serves as program Manager for the Army's Patient Centered Medical Home (PCMH). Provides subject matter expert (SME) guidance to the Army PCMH Task Force. Charged with providing behavioral health (BH) consultation and SME guidance to Army leadership on the PCMH and assessing competencies of Army Internal BH Consultants. Requires dedication of 49% of incumbent's time to conducting training, directly participating in training delivery, and developing training and policy at the OTSG/MEDCOM level for integrated BH into the Army PCMH to support best practices and improve access to care. Mandatory dedication of 51% time spent as Clinical Psychologist, providing direct clinical services and care at WRNMMC within the PCMH model. Must have training and experience as a BH Consultant in a military primary care setting. The position requires strong written and oral communication skills, extensive experience with developing training programs, delivery of training, and consultation with senior military leaders.

Will spend at least 51% of time as a Clinical Psychologist providing direct clinical services and care at WRNMMC within the Patient Centered Medical Home model.

Maintains all basic readiness standards as required by the U.S. Public Health Service. Requires a Secret clearance.

PHS officers assigned under this Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) must remain available for PHS deployments. Under this MOA, PHS officers are not authorized to deploy with the military.

Requirements:

License: A current, unrestricted, and valid license as a doctoral-level clinical psychologist from a U.S. State (as defined in 42 USC 201 (f)) is required.

Training: The candidate must possess a doctoral degree in clinical or counseling psychology from an American Psychological Association accredited doctoral program and an APA-accredited internship.

Additional Requirements:

Must be an active duty PHS officer with a minimum of two years in the Corps and documented experience working with military leadership. Applicants are asked to submit current CV, copies of last two COERs and reference from current employee/coc. Candidates with experience working with the DoD preferred. Initial assignment term is a 3-year obligation, with the option to extend.
