Army: Licensed Clinical Psychologist, Blanchfield Army Community Hospital, Fort Campbell, KY (O4 billet)

Job Description:

The clinical psychologist will perform outpatient psychotherapeutic management of Active Duty Army Soldiers. There is emphasis on anxiety, depression, and PTSD. There are opportunities for short term trauma-focused psychotherapy, psychological testing, and evaluations related to forensic/disability work.

(At minimum 51% of the officer's time will be in clinical mental health work.)

Requirements:

License: A current, unrestricted, and valid license as a clinical psychologist from a U.S. State, District of Columbia, Commonwealth, Territory, or other jurisdiction is required.

Training: The candidate must possess a qualifying doctoral degree in clinical psychology from an American Psychological Association (APA) accredited university or professional psychology program. Shall have completed an APA accredited internship/residency in clinical psychology.

Additional Requirements:

On-Call Responsibilities: BACH is supported by a Behavioral Health emergency service, which is staffed by LCSWs with onsite ER physician support. There is one month of telephone consultation only to this ER service.
