Job Description:

Serves as Clinical Care Coordinator for the Warrior Transition Battalion (WTB) responsible for identification, tracking, and care coordinator for medically redeployed Soldiers from Operation New Dawn and Operation Enduring Freedom. Subject matter expert and advocate for care coordination throughout the medical evaluation process with separation for a seamless transition to the Veteran Administration System. Primary proponent to identify the appropriate population design programs and oversee all clinical care coordination of defined groups. Provides timely initial and follow-up assessments of high-risk, high cost and problem prone patients. Collaborates with the patient, Primary Care Managers, multidisciplinary team, completes multi- systems evaluations, preliminary problem list, and comprehensive transitional care plan with timelines and goals (mind, body, heart, and spirit). Coordinates changes with the patient as they move along the entire health care continuum with the goal to expedite treatment and transition to either return to duty or release from service.

Requirements:

License: A current, unrestricted and valid nursing license from one of the 50 states, Washington, D.C., the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, the US Virgin Islands or Guam is required.

Training: The Candidate must possess a qualifying bachelor's degree or a master's degree (with no qualifying baccalaureate degree) from a nursing program that is accredited by the National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission or the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education

Passing score on the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX).

Experience as Registered Nurse with Nurse Care Management background.
