

Position Title:

Licensed Psychologist: Clinical Director, Embedded Behavioral Health Support Cell (O6 Supervisory Billet)

Job Duties:

Directly supports the Comprehensive Behavioral Health System of Care Campaign Plan by serving as the clinical expert within the Embedded Behavioral Health (EBH) cell at Fort Carson, CO. The EBH Support Cell Clinical Director provides direct consultation to medical treatment facilities (MTF) across MEDCOM as they establish EBH teams. Serves as the subject matter expert on clinical processes, such as patient flow patterns, triage systems, personnel management and clinical outcomes. Distributes and explains key SOP's, such as those governing establishing and maintaining rapport with a brigade's chain of command and organic medical staff. The clinical director will maintain a caseload of active duty Soldiers 51% of the time.

The officer is required to perform at minimum 51% clinical mental health work.

Direct patient care will include:

Evaluations for sniper, drill sergeant and recruiter schools; retention evaluations; seeing Soldiers for psychological triage.

Indirect patient care will include:

Providing supervision to Social Service Agents; assess how Soldiers are doing in regard to their treatment goals with their off-post providers.

Requirements:

A current, unrestricted, and valid license as a doctoral-level clinical psychologist from a U.S. State (as defined in 42 USC 201 (f)) is required. Clinical Psychologist encompasses psychologists in clinical, counseling, community, rehabilitation and related practice specialties where practice is an expectation during the officer's Corps career and thus, a license is required.

The candidate must possess a qualifying doctoral degree in clinical psychology from an American Psychological Association accredited university or professional psychology program.

Must have attended an APA accredited internship or be ABPP certified. Must also have extensive knowledge of EBH and greater than 2 years of experience of leadership within EBH.

Some travel is required for this assignment.
