Nurse Case Manager (03 billet)

Job Description:

The Nurse will perform case management (CM) of Active Duty Army Soldiers in a clinic setting. There is emphasis on anxiety, depression, and PTSD. The primary role will be to liaise with outpatient providers, civilian inpatient treatment teams/hospital, day programs, military units, and the Soldier plus his/her primary supports. There are opportunities injection clinics for depot antipsychotics and naltrexone.

(At least 51% of incumbent's time must be spent on direct mental health patient care and/or mental health clinical management).

Requirements:

License: A current, unrestricted, and valid Registered Nurse (RN) license from a U.S. State, District of Columbia, Commonwealth Territory, or other jurisdiction is required. Licensure of nurses, who graduated after 1 December 1988, must be based on passing the National Council of State Boards of Nursing Licensure Exam.

Training: A candidate must possess a qualifying bachelor's degree in nursing or a master's degree in nursing (with no qualifying bachelor's degree) accredited by the National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission (NLNAC) or the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE).

Additional Requirements:

Officer must be in good professional standing.
