Joint Task Force CAPMED: Clinical Psychologist - Fort Belvoir, VA (O-4 billet, Non-Supervisory)

Job Description:

Clinical psychologist provides behavioral health (BH) care to 6-8 patients per day in a clinical setting; individual and group counseling services also offered in the outpatient BH clinic. Duties include providing direct psychological assessment, diagnosis, and treatment to uniformed service members and their families (to include children and geriatric populations). Provides consultations with primary care managers. Incumbent will participate in multidisciplinary clinical case staffing; conducts command-directed mental health evaluations and evaluations for security clearances. Manages suicidal/homicidal patients, to include the arrangement of emergency hospitalizations, as appropriate. Oversees and/or conducts preventive mental health/substance abuse prevention services as appropriate. Supervises, mentors, and trains unlicensed providers and technician staff, as appropriate. May provide clinical supervision for psychology residents and social work interns. Participates on and/or directs military-specific trainings, such as disaster response. Performs other duties as assigned.

At least 51% of the incumbent's time will be spent on direct mental health patient care and/or mental health clinical management.

Maintains all basic readiness standards as required by the U.S. Public Health Service. There are on-call responsibilities associated with this job.

PHS officers assigned under this Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) must remain available for PHS deployments. Under this MOA, PHS officers are not authorized to deploy with the military.

Requirements:

ULicense: A current, unrestricted, and valid license as a doctoral-level clinical psychologist from a U.S. State (as defined in 42 USC 201 (f)) is required.

Training: The candidate must possess a qualifying doctoral degree in clinical or counseling psychology from an American Psychological Association (APA) accredited university or professional psychology program. Must have completed an APA-accredited internship/residency in clinical psychology.

Additional Requirements:

Experience with military populations is preferred. Experience with diagnosis and treatment of PTSD and/or dual diagnosis patients is preferred. Experience with substance use disorders is preferred.

This job requires a minimum of a 3 year commitment.
