

**Job Title:**

NAVY: Psychologist - Naval Hospital Camp Lejeune, NC (O-4 billet, Non-Supervisory)

**Job Description:**

This position is that of a Clinical Psychologist assigned to the Directorate of Mental Health (DMH), which has three separate clinic locations aboard Camp Lejeune, NC. The primary purpose of this position is to provide broad-based and psychological services to include evaluation, diagnosis, treatment, and appropriate disposition of the service member within the Marine Corps Base and the Naval Hospital. The scope of duty encompasses primary and continuing care of service members, including preventive mental health measures, mental health maintenance, and mental health education service. The service provided will be commensurate with the highest standards of quality patient care and in accordance with the quality assurance standards of Naval Hospital, Camp Lejeune, NC. The Clinical Psychologist assists in assurance of adequate coverage of all clinic operating hours, coordination of all patient care, and administrative activities pertaining to the mental health care needs of the service member seen in DMH. Interfacing with the DMH staff, the Clinical Psychologist will ensure optimal mental health care to all active duty personnel. This position allows for a wide range of flexibility and independence responsive to the changing needs of the service member and staff population.

Will at least spend 51% of time on direct mental health patient care and/or mental health clinical management (deployment health).

Maintains all basic readiness standards as required by the U.S. Public Health Service. Requires a Secret clearance.

PHS officers assigned under this Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) must remain available for PHS deployments. Under this MOA, PHS officers are not authorized to deploy with the military.

**Requirements:**

License: A doctoral degree (PhD or PsyD) in clinical or counseling psychology from an accredited university or professional school, a 1 year clinical internship is required. A current, unrestricted, and valid psychologist license from a U.S. State (as defined in 42 USC 201 (f)) is required.

**Additional Requirements:**

Training from a broad background of mental health experience and knowledge. This allows for accurate mental health assessment of individuals. CHCS/AHLTA Training. Initial assignment term is a 3-year obligation.
