NAVY: Clinical Psychologist-Joint Base Pearl Harbor; Hickam, HI (O-4 billet, Non-Supervisory)

Job Description:

Clinical Psychologist will working in the Mental Health department at either Pearl Harbor or BHC Kaneohe Clinic. The position includes evaluation, diagnosis, treatment, and consultation for patients of all ages with psychological disorders through the application of psychological techniques for the purpose of understanding, preventing, and relieving psychologically-based distress or dysfunction and to promote subjective well-being and personal development. They may administer and interpret various psychological tests, perform evaluations to determine risk of harm, fitness for duty, and suitability for duty. They work with individuals, couples, families, small groups, and communities. The Clinical Psychologist in this position may be a team leader, may supervise post-doctoral psychologists, and may participate with Substance Abuse Rehabilitation Program (SARP) counselors in the evaluation and treatment of patients in treatment for substance abuse. May provide periodic clinical supervision of unlicensed psychologists.

On-call responsibilities include Command Duty Officer 1-2 times quarterly.

Minimum 3-year commitment.

Maintains all basic readiness standards as required by the U.S. Public Health Service. Requires a Secret clearance.

PHS officers assigned under this Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) must remain available for PHS deployments. Under this MOA, PHS officers are not authorized to deploy with the military.

Requirements:

License: A current, unrestricted, and valid license as a doctoral level clinical psychologist from a U.S. State (as defined in 42 USC 201 (f)) is required.

Training: The candidate must possess a qualifying doctoral degree (Ph.D. or Psy.D.) in clinical psychology or counseling Psychology from an American Psychological Association accredited university or professional psychology program and an APA approved internship.

Additional Requirements:

Initial assignment term is a 3-year obligation.
