NAVY: Psychologist-Project Manager for Behavioral Health Integration Program-Navy Medicine BUMED Headquarters; Falls Church, VA (O-5 billet, Supervisory)

Job Description:

The Project Manager for the Behavioral Health Integration Program (BHIP) provides direct care services in the Medical Home setting. Other duties include training development, training delivery, and policy development at the Navy Medicine (BUMED) Headquarters level and in the field. Responsibilities include management of a small team of subject matter experts developing policy, developing training plans, directly participating in training delivery, providing supervision, and assessing competencies in the field. In addition, the incumbent will serve as chief consultant to the Navy Medicine Program Office for Medical Home Port. Must have training and experience as a Behavioral Health Consultant in a military primary care setting. The position requires extensive training experience, both in developing training programs and in providing direct training and supervision. At least 51% of the officer's time will be spent in clinical mental health work. Minimum 3-year commitment.

Maintains all basic readiness standards as required by the U.S. Public Health Service. Requires a Secret clearance.

PHS officers assigned under this Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) must remain available for PHS deployments. Under this MOA, PHS officers are not authorized to deploy with the military.

Requirements:

License: A current, unrestricted, and valid license as a doctoral level clinical psychologist from a U.S. State (as defined in 42 USC 201 (f)) is required.

Training: The candidate must possess a qualifying doctoral degree in clinical psychology from an American Psychological Association accredited university or professional psychology program and an APA approved internship.

Additional Requirements:

Must have training and experience as a Behavioral Health Consultant in a military primary care setting. Initial assignment term is a 3-year obligation.
