Navy: Staff Psychiatrist, U.S. Naval Hospital Naples, Italy, (O3-O6 billet)

**Job Description:**

Serves as a full performance level psychiatrist at U S Naval Hospital Naples. Applies professional knowledge of adult and child psychiatry by independently performing the following major duties:

- Identifies and diagnoses psychological, emotional, medical, and behavioral issues and disorders.
- Utilizes a variety of psychotherapeutic and medication management techniques to develop, implement, assess, and modify individual treatment plans, specifying the type, frequency, intensity, and duration of therapy.
- Interacts with patients to assist them in gaining insight, defining goals, and planning actions to achieve effective development and adjustment.
- Provides counseling to individuals and groups regarding behavioral problems, physical and mental illnesses, and physical rehabilitation in order to modify behavior or improve personal, social, and vocational adjustment.
- Conducts interviews and reviews medical records to obtain medical, psychological, social, and family histories.
- Administers and interprets medical tests for differentiating between physical and mental causes of behavioral disorders, and to aid in diagnosing mental and personality disorders.
- Collaborates with other physicians and medical professionals to develop and implement treatment and intervention programs.
- Prepares reports and documentation of patient diagnoses and treatments in Ahlta.
- Consults a variety of reference materials including textbooks, manuals, and journals in order to identify

(At minimum 51% of the officer's time will be in clinical mental health work.)

**Requirements:**

*License:* A current, unrestricted and valid medical license from a U.S. State, District of Columbia, Commonwealth, Territory, or other jurisdiction is required.

*Training:* The candidate must possess a qualifying Doctor of Medicine (M.D.) or Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine (D.O.) degree from a medical school that is accredited by the Council of Medical Education of the American Medical Association of Bureau of Professional Education, Committee on Colleges of the American Osteopathic Association, respectively.

However, candidates who are graduates of medical schools that are not located in the U.S. State, District of Columbia, Commonwealth, Territory or other jurisdiction, or a Province or Territory of Canada, may be appointed if they are certified by the Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates and meet all other requirements for appointment.

**Minimum 3 year commitment.**

**Additional Requirements:**

Preference to board certified psychiatrist with child/adolescent fellowship training.  
On-call with other providers.
