**Job Description:**

The Deputy Service Chief works under the direct supervision of the Service Chief, Resiliency and Psychological Health Service. The Deputy Service Chief is responsible for assisting the Service Chief will accomplishing the following responsibilities: 1) managing the day-to-day operation of the service; 2) supervising a multi-disciplinary staff of military and civilian social workers, behavioral health technicians, and para-professionals who provide targeted preventative services and programs that promote wellness, readiness, and adaptability; 3) providing direct supervision to a Non-Commissioned Officer In-Charge of the Resiliency and Psychological Health Service; 4) serving as a resiliency subject matter expert and overseeing all aspects of educational and outreach activities provided by staff; 5) assisting with management of an estimated \$270,000 annual budget; 6) establishing goals and objectives for the Resiliency and Psychological Health Service; 7) providing guidance for designing outreach activities, developing educational programs, and ensuring compliance with quality assurance programs; and 8) providing direct client services.

This position would provide a full range of psycho-educational services to all staff detailed to WRNMMC and within the NCR. The Deputy Service Chief is vital for ensuring successful completion of the Resiliency and Psychological Health Service's mission which is to directly support the psychological health and resiliency of 7000+ WRNMMC staff. provide care and treatment to Wounded, Ill and Injured Service Members. A significant component of the service is to reduce provider fatigue, secondary trauma, and burnout among the dedicated staff. The position will serve as a resiliency consultant for executive leaders and mid-level supervisors stationed at WRNMMC, Fort Belvoir, the Pentagon and other DoD organizations within the NCR.

This position will also be responsible for providing individual and/or marital therapy to OIF/OEF wounded warriors and other eligible beneficiaries who seek treatment in Adult Outpatient Behavioral Health Clinic. The primary duty location will be at WRNMMC, although the position will be targeted to provide psycho-educational services throughout the NCR.

Maintains all basic readiness standards as required by the U.S. Public Health Service. PHS officers assigned under this Memorandum of Agreement (MOA)

must remain available for PHS deployments. Under this MOA, PHS officers are not authorized to deploy with the military. 3-year (minimum) assignment tour.

Requires a SECRET clearance.

**CREDENTIALS, QUALIFICATIONS, EXPERIENCE REQUIRED:**

License: Requires a valid, unrestricted registration or certification that allows for independent clinical social work practice in a U.S. State or other jurisdiction.

Training: The candidate must possess a qualifying master's degree in social work from a program that is accredited by the Council on Social Work Education (CSWE).
