*****JOB DESCRIPTION*****

- PHS Psychologist or LCSW will serve as senior mental health officer aboard Naval Weapons Station Yorktown and senior advisor to the Regimental Commanding Officer to Marine Corps Security Force Regiment.
- PHS Psychologist or LCSW will support Marine Corps Security Force Regiment and subordinate battalions through participation in the Regimental Force Preservation Council and membership in the Command Team Leadership Committee.
- PHS Psychologist or LCSW will support Marine Corps Security Force Regiment Sexual Assault Response Coordinator (SARC) and Base SARC, both in restricted and unrestricted reporting pathways.
- PHS Psychologist will oversee Personnel Reliability Program (PRP) Pre-screening of students at the Basic Security Guard School conducted at the MCSFR Training Company at Northwest Annex in Chesapeake, Virginia.
- PHS Psychologist or LCSW will provide assessment and outpatient mental health care (primary duty) to active duty and eligible beneficiaries to include individual and group therapy.
- PHS Psychologist or LCSW will train embedded Corpsmen and civilian technicians on screening and managing mental health issues.
- PHS Psychologist or LCSW will provide tele-health to eligible beneficiaries.

*****CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT*****

Clinical Psychologist will have a doctoral degree or equivalent in clinical psychology and a license to practice in one of the 50 states. Social Worker will be licensed as a Licensed Clinical Social Worker in one of the 50 states. Must be eligible for standard privileges at Naval Medical Center Portsmouth.
